Add some interest to a simple washcloth by giving it a Valentine theme. These heart washcloths are great to keep, or give as a gift to let someone know you care any time of the year.

The Double Moss Stitch heart makes a plain cloth more interesting, and is great as a spa-inspired gift when paired with fancy handmade soap and tied up with a ribbon.

DIFFICULTY

Easy - techniques used: knit, purl, counting rows

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Approximately 9.5 inches square

MATERIALS

Lily Sugar'n Cream Solids [100% cotton; 95yds/87m per 2oz/57g skein]; colour: Red, 2274819; 1 skein

1 pair US 7 (4.5 mm) needles

GAUGE

16 sts/24 rows = 4" in stockinette stitch

ABBREVIATIONS

K	knit
P	purl
RS	right side
st(s)	stitches
WS	wrong side

Cloth

With US 7 needle, cast on 43 sts.

Work in Moss Stitch for 6 rows as follows:

*K1, P1, repeat from * to last stitch, K1.

(NB: If you want neat edges, slip the first st knitwise and knit the last st on RS rows, and slip the first st purlwise and purl the last st on WS rows. If you do this, don't include it in the Moss Stitch pattern).


Next row (RS): Work 5 sts in Moss Stitch, then work 33 sts of Heart Chart, starting at Row 1, and 5 sts in Moss Stitch.

Next row (WS): Work 5 sts in Moss Stitch, then work 33 sts of Heart Chart (Row 2), and 5 sts in Moss Stitch.

Keeping a count of your rows, continue working the Heart Chart until it is complete - keeping 5 sts of Moss Stitch at either side.

When chart is complete, work 6 more rows in Moss Stitch.

Bind off all sts. Weave in ends and block.
